

Chocolate Cream Soldier

The name Chocolate Cream Soldier is a parody, an irony that allows the dramatist to satirise the hollowness of the dual romanticism of Victorian prudery (prudishness) - War and Love.

The name is derived from Raina's coining it when to her utter dismay she finds Bluntschli advocating the necessity of carrying chocolates instead of cartridges in the battlefield, for they are more useful at moment of long starvation and suffering. He reveals this prodigal theory after he is saved from the search party by Raina. She provides him chocolates and he
